If you cannot provide one of the previous three forms of evidence, other evidence may be acceptable. For example, a minor may present parent's proof of residency. Other evidence must be clear and convincing, and show intent to maintain a permanent residence in Arizona. Proof of ownership of property or establishing an abode in Arizona is not acceptable unless supplemented by other information showing intent.

Residency. For purposes of the Motion Picture Production Tax Incentive Program, a person must be domiciled in Arizona. A domicile is a permanent home, a place not used for a temporary or transitory purpose, a place where a person spends more than nine-months of the taxable year; it is a place to which a person intends to return after any temporary absence. A person can have only one domicile. A change in domicile is effected only by establishing a physical presence in a new location with the intent to abandon the old domicile and make a home in the new location permanently or indefinitely. A.R.S. § 43-104.
